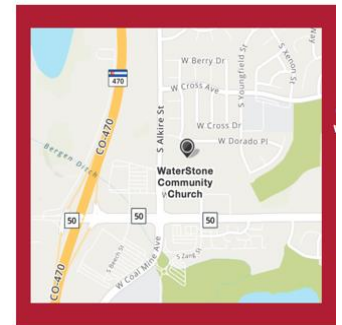

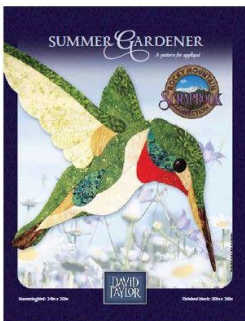


**May 18, 2023** in person, noon - 3PM The guild presents a "**A Historic Narrative of Quilting from an African American Perspective**" lecture and trunk show.
