If you have an event coming up in the next few months, get info. to me before January 6 (Early submissions appreciated). My notes go out to about 500 quilters for lots of FREE publicity.

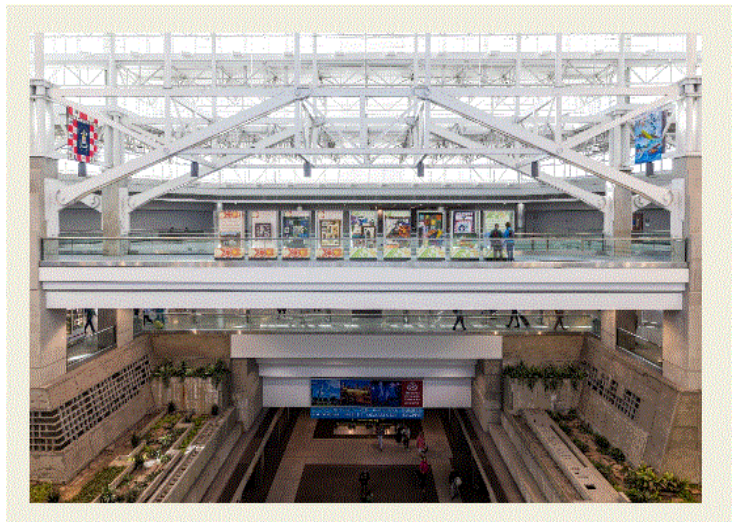

DEN Arts presents **Perfect Patchwork**, a celebration of quilting in Colorado!

This exhibition includes three diverse guilds, the [Colorado Quilting Council](#), the [Rocky Mountain Wa Shonaji Quilt Guild](#), and the [Denver Metro Modern Quilt Guild](#), along with the local [Rocky Mountain Quilt Museum](#). These quilts represent the city of Denver, capture the essence of Colorado's natural beauty, and depict themes of aviation.

Be immersed in a kaleidoscope of colors, textures, and patterns that tell stories as unique and diverse as the talented quilters who created them. Perfect Patchwork showcases the incredible range and creativity that can be achieved with fabric, needle, and thread.



Most of the pieces are located along the overpass to A Gate and in other public spaces, before going through security. (Also, on level 3 of Concourse C).

Featuring 100 works representing three diverse guilds and one museum: **The Colorado Quilting Council**, **The Rocky Mountain Wa Shonaji Quilt Guild**, **The Denver Metro Modern Quilt Guild**, and **The Rocky Mountain Quilt Museum**. This exhibit is located in Ansbacher Hall, near A-Bridge security, and on level three of Concourse C, and includes large hanging quilts, unique quilted clothing and a variety of expertly crafted quilts in different shapes and sizes. 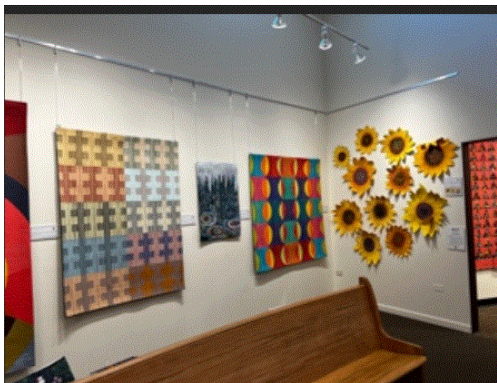
25 Years of Scraps | 19th Century Patchwork Divas

A group of 12-24 women in Texas, the 19th Century Patchwork Divas, use their expert stitching and designing skills to recreate and reinterpret scrap quilts originally created in the 1800's.

Over 25 years, they have challenged each other through block exchanges and the resulting quilts are magnificent.

65 exchanges have resulted in over 600 quilts, lifelong friendships and 2 books – “History Repeated” in 2011 and “Treasury of Quilts” in 2016 (available in the RMQM store.)

Diana Fox Solo Exhibit | Outside the Frame's Edge



Starting as a traditional quilter in 1983, Diana transitioned to art quilts in 2007 and has taken them to new levels and dimensions. (3D in fact).

In recent years – being invited to a small art quilt group, 4 Common Corners, has challenged Diana to go Outside the Frame's Edge and explore the depths of her quilt projects. Beauty, color, texture, intention and LOTS of thread are all part of her current works in her solo exhibit.

CQC January 27, 2024, Kate Colleran live at the church or zoom from home.

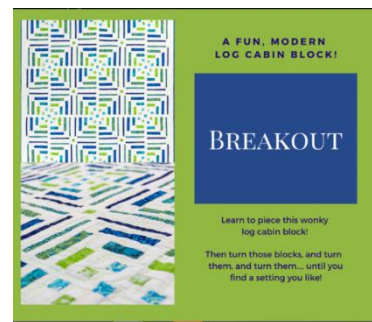
