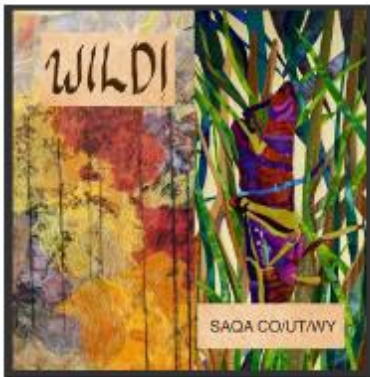

Reclamation Alchemy, Potential and Beauty in Used Materials by Eliu Hernandez.

Eliu's tool of choice is a seam ripper, and he gets very excited spotting new 'raw materials' of used jeans, with character. Dedicated to making beautiful and functional works using reclaimed materials, he uses clothing, bedding and other fabrics to make quilts, stuffed animals and other functional items.

His insight and inspiration will have you looking twice at materials you would otherwise throw away.
